COVID-19 Questions & Answers

We must all continue to minimise the risk of spreading Covid-19.

Always follow National Guidance and please stay at home if you feel unwell. If you have tested positive or someone you have been in close contact with has tested positive for Coronavirus, please delay your visit. We will happily rearrange your booking.

Answers to key questions follow:

Do I need to book a table in the pub?

Because legal social distancing requirements have been lifted, we can accept a greater number of guests. But this is limited to the size of our team and to avoid disappointment, we recommend that tables are booked. This is particularly necessary during our popular sessions such as Friday evenings, Saturdays and Sundays.

Can I order food and drinks at the bar?

We are happy for you to order drinks at the bar. We do ask that once you receive your pint you grab a seat. We hope to reintroduce the joy of drinking a pint at the bar in the near future.

Do I need to wear a mask inside the pub?

The wearing of face masks or coverings is no longer a legal requirement. But you may feel more comfortable wearing one inside if the pub is busy. For the moment, some of our team members have chosen to continue wearing masks inside.

Will contact details be collected?

Although not required, you can still use the NHS Track and Trace system to check into our venue. We will continue to display our QR code at the main entrance.

Are enhanced hygiene arrangements still in place?

The inside and outside of our pub are thoroughly cleaned each day. Every member of our Front of House Team is responsible for making sure that tables, chairs and touch points (including payment terminals) are regularly cleaned and sanitised. Please alert a team member if a table or space needs additional attention.

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Is hand sanitiser available?

Yes. At our main entrance and in a few points around the pub. But we recommend you carry your favourite brand of hand sanitiser with you. And please continue washing your hands thoroughly and regularly.

What time can I check into a cabin or the campsite?

Check-in is between 2pm and 8pm. Please contact us if you would like to check in earlier and we will do our best to help.

What time is Check-out?

We ask that you check out of your cabin by 10am and from our campsite by noon. When you leave your pod, please leave the key in the front of the door.

How do you ventilate the inside of your building?

To enable air to circulate, we will keep a number of our bar and restaurant doors and windows open. We are very much looking forward to your visit.

Please note that children must always be supervised by their parents or guardians.

Remember to wash your hands regularly and please stay at home if you feel at all unwell.

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
